
Summary of the Research Activities

I am studying the regulations related to the development of green spaces in the *Bebauungs-plan* (Building plan) in the Riem district of Munich, Germany. In Japan, the district plan was institutionalized in 1980, and at that time the West German *Bebauungsplan* was referenced.


German *Bebauungsplan* has detailed plans for greening and planting, in addition to building codes and urban planning. In Japan, on the other hand, urban planning has architectural regulations, but the regulations of greening and planting are not planned in detail.

I had already translated the regulations of the Bebauungsplan in the Riem district of

Munich in Japan. The purpose of the research in Munich is to see in the field if the regulations are fulfilled.
